## What's the Mini-Grant?

The Community Foundation of Greater Flint Neighborhoods Small Grants Program and the City of Flint Master Plan are offering **\$500** mini-grants to neighborhood groups for completing inventories of houses and lots in **Flint** neighborhoods.

### What's a neighborhood inventory?

Scoring the condition of houses and identifying vacant lots in your neighborhood.

### Why is the inventory important?

Recording what's in your neighborhood is a big step in planning for the future.

### What's Required?

- A commitment from 2 or 3 people from your neighborhood group
- Participation in a one-hour training
- A completed inventory of your neighborhood by September 28, 2012.

### Who's Eligible?

Neighborhood groups that:

- Have a bank account
- Have a DBA ("Doing Business As") registration with Genesee County
